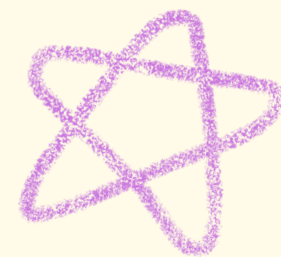
## Community Connection Grants:

There were 4 community connection grants approved this fiscal year. \$100 for live another day event, \$250 for Martha's Choice event, \$75 for community outing with for a community member and her kids, \$100 for rail pass for a community member's new job, appointments, etc.

## Mental Health Needs Assessment:

278 MontCo residents and employees participated in this survey. Results showed that the top 5 priorities are: Housing, crisis services, peer support, employment and education, and a tie for 5th place - treatment/therapy and residential.

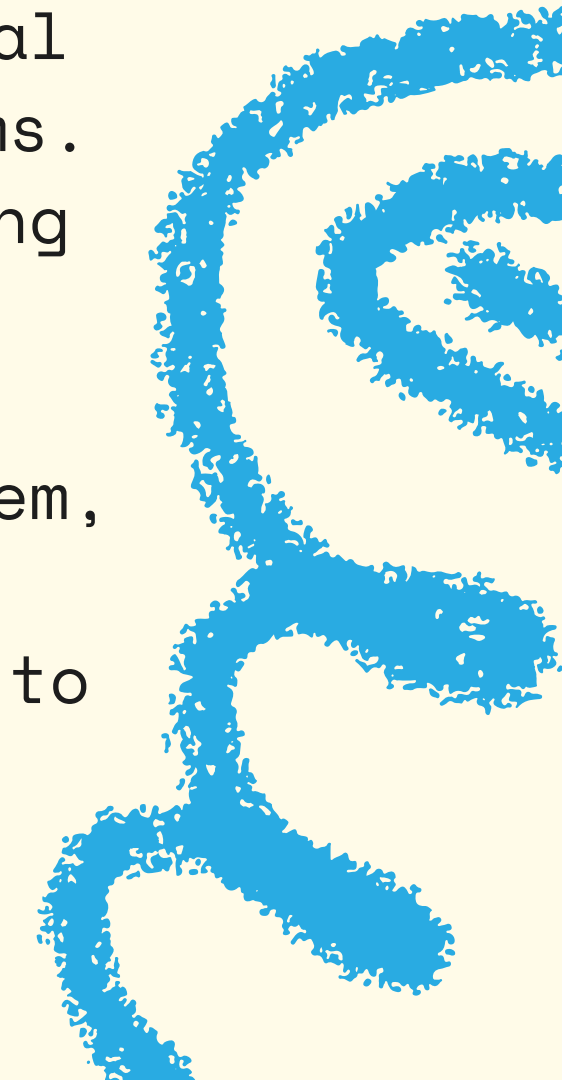

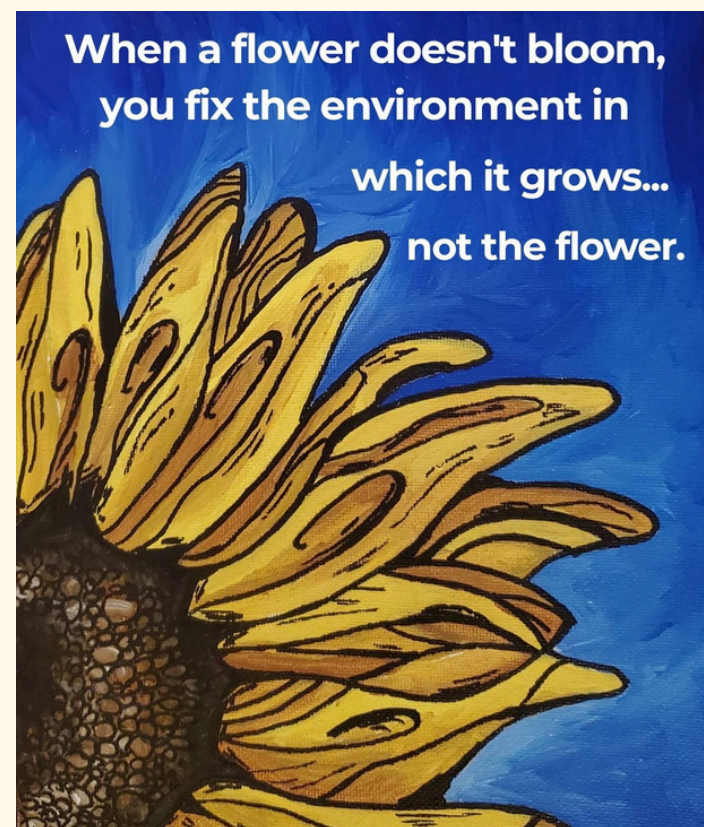

# MEETINGS





## **In person:**
